Individual Lessons

Weekly individual lessons are available for ages 4 to adult. All instruments including voice are taught by our professional teaching artists. An instrument is required. All lessons are scheduled for a specific day and time. Office hours are Monday through Friday from 9am to 8pm.

Individual Lesson Cost

- 30 minutes..... \$29 per lesson
